“When they had crossed over, they came to the land of Gennesaret. ³⁵ And when the men of that place recognized Him, they sent out into all that surrounding region, brought to Him all who were sick, ³⁶ and begged Him that they might only touch the hem of His garment. And as many as touched it were made perfectly well.”

2: Did Jesus Have A Methodology to Healing?



A) 5 Accounts of Jesus Healing the Blind.

Other Accounts of Jesus healing blind people, but no method was given: Matt. 11:5; Matt. 12:22; Matt. 15:30; Matt. 21:14; and Luke 7:21.



**Jesus touched the eyes of
two blind men:**

“And Jesus said to them, “Do you believe that I am able to do this?” They said to Him, “Yes, Lord.”²⁹ Then He touched their eyes, saying, “According to your faith let it be to you.”³⁰ And their eyes were opened.” Matthew 9:28-30 (NKJV)



**Spit into and touched the eyes,
touched the eyes again:**

“Then He came to Bethsaida; and they brought a blind man to Him, and begged Him to touch him. ²³ So He took the blind man by the hand and led him out of the town. And when He had spit on his eyes and put His hands on him, He asked him if he saw anything.



**Spit into and touched the eyes,
touched the eyes again:**

*24 And he looked up and said, "I see
men like trees, walking." 25 Then He
put His hands on his eyes again and
made him look up. And he was restored
and saw everyone clearly."*

Mark 8:22-25 (NKJV)



**No touching, no nothing.
Jesus said it, and it was done.**

“What do you want Me to do for you?” The blind man said to Him, “Rabboni, that I may receive my sight.”⁵² Then Jesus said to him, “Go your way; your faith has made you well.” And immediately he received his sight and followed Jesus on the road.” Mark 9:51,52 (NKJV)



Jesus spat in dirt, made mud, anointed eyes, told the man to wash in the pool of Siloam, and he was healed.

“When He had said these things, He spat on the ground and made clay with the saliva; and He anointed the eyes of the blind man with the clay. ⁷ And He said to him, “Go, wash in the pool of Siloam” (which is translated, Sent). So he went and washed, and came back seeing.” John 9:6,7 (NKJV)



Summary:
There is no one correct method.



Paul Gives a Methodology for Healing:

“Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. ¹⁵ And the prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise him up.”



James 5:14,15 (NKJV)



3. Ask Jesus, and Let Him Do What He Wills:



Many times, Jesus said, “according to your faith.”



*“Jesus turned, and seeing her he said, “Take heart, daughter; your faith has made you well.”
And instantly the woman was made well.”*

Matthew 9:22 (ESV)



*“Then he touched their eyes, saying,
“According to your faith be it done to you.”*

Matthew 9:29 (ESV)



*“Then Jesus answered her, “O woman, great is your faith! Be it done for you as you desire.”
And her daughter was healed instantly.”*

Matthew 15:28 (ESV)



“I say to you, if you have faith as a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, ‘Move from here to there,’ and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you.” Matthew 17:20 (NKJV)
