WHAT IS DARKNESS?

And this is the judgment: the light has come into the world, and people loved the darkness rather than the light because their works were evil.

- 1 John 3:19 (ESV)

Take no part in the unfruitful works of darkness, but instead expose them. For it is shameful even to speak of the things that they do in secret. But when anything is exposed by the light, it becomes visible.

Ephesians 5:11-13 (ESV)

Now this I say and testify in the Lord, that you must no longer walk as the Gentiles do, in the futility of their minds. They are darkened in their understanding, alienated from the life of God because of the ignorance that is in them, due to their hardness of heart. They have become callous and have given themselves up to sensuality, greedy to practice every kind of impurity. Ephesians 4:17-19 (ESV)

Romans 1:21-32 (ESV)

For although they knew God, they did not honor him as God or give thanks to him, but they became **futile** in their **thinking**, and their **foolish hearts** were **darkened**. Claiming to be wise, they became fools, and <u>exchanged the glory of the immortal</u>

<u>God for images resembling mortal man and birds and</u>

<u>animals and creeping things.</u>

Therefore God gave them up in the **lusts of their hearts** to impurity, to the dishonoring of their bodies among themselves, because they exchanged the truth about God for a lie and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed forever! Amen.

For this reason God gave them up to dishonorable passions. For their women exchanged natural relations for those that are contrary to nature; and the men likewise gave up natural relations with women and were consumed with passion for one another, men committing shameless acts with men and receiving in themselves the due penalty for their error.

And since they did not see fit to acknowledge God, God gave them up to a debased mind to do what ought not to be done. They were filled with all manner of unrighteousness, evil, covetousness, malice. They are full of envy, murder, strife, deceit, maliciousness. They are gossips, slanderers, haters of God, insolent, haughty, boastful, inventors of evil, disobedient to parents, foolish, faithless, heartless, ruthless. Though they know God's righteous decree that those who practice such things deserve to die, they not only do them but give approval to those who practice them.

Isaiah 6:9-10




If darkness or not being able to see is a mind-related issue,

Psalmist/Ancient Israelite: The Torah


The first-century Jew: The law and the Prophets

Hebrews 1:1-2 (NIV)

In the past God **spoke** to our ancestors through the **prophets** at many times and in various ways, but <u>in these last days</u> he has **spoken** to us by **his Son**, whom he appointed heir of all things, and through whom also he made the universe.

THE WORD: The Person/Matter



In the beginning was the **Word**, and the **Word** was with God, and the **Word** was God.

The **Word** became **flesh** and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.

The risk of **blindness** is ever present

2 Peter 1:2-11 (NET)

...May grace and peace be lavished on you as you grow in the rich knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord! I can pray this because his divine power has bestowed on us everything necessary for life and godliness through the rich knowledge of the one who called us by his own glory and excellence. Through these things he has bestowed on us his precious and most magnificent promises, so that by means of what was promised you may become partakers of the divine nature, after escaping the worldly corruption that is produced by evil desire. For this very reason, make every effort to add to your faith excellence, to excellence, knowledge; to knowledge, self-control; to self-control, perseverance; to perseverance, godliness; to godliness, brotherly affection; to brotherly affection, unselfish love.

For if these things are really yours and are continually increasing, they will keep you from becoming ineffective and unproductive in your pursuit of knowing our Lord Jesus Christ more intimately. But concerning the one who **lacks** such things—**he is blind**. That is to say, he is **nearsighted**, since he has forgotten about the cleansing of his past sins. Therefore, brothers and sisters, make every effort to be sure of your calling and election. For by doing this you will never stumble into sin. For thus an entrance into the eternal kingdom of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, will be richly provided for you.
