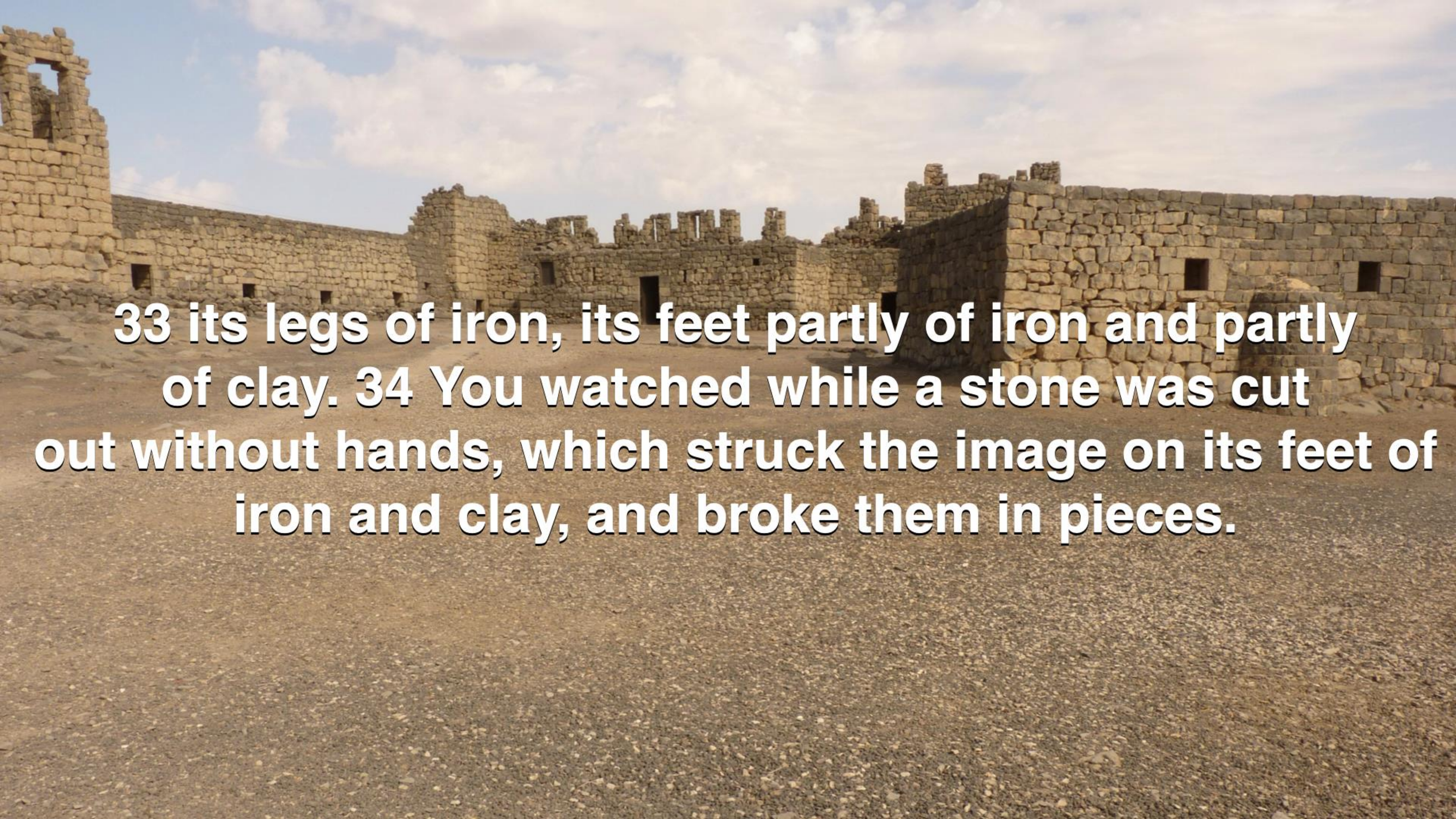





# 1. Daniels 1st Vision: (Daniel 2)

“37 You, O king, are a king of kings. For the God of heaven has given you a kingdom, power, strength, and glory; 38 and wherever the children of men dwell, or the beasts of the field and the birds of the heaven, He has given them into your hand, and has made you ruler over them all—you are this head of gold.” Daniel 2:37,38 (NKJV)



B) The Chest of Silver:  
The Next Kingdom that is Inferior.

“39 But after you shall arise another  
kingdom inferior to yours;”

C) The Belly and Thighs of Bronze:  
“... then another, a third kingdom of  
bronze, which shall rule over all the  
earth.” Daniel 2:39b



## D) Legs of Iron:

“40 And the fourth kingdom shall be as strong as iron, inasmuch as iron breaks in pieces and shatters everything; and like iron that crushes, that kingdom will break in pieces and crush all the others.”



## **E) Feet of Iron and Clay:**

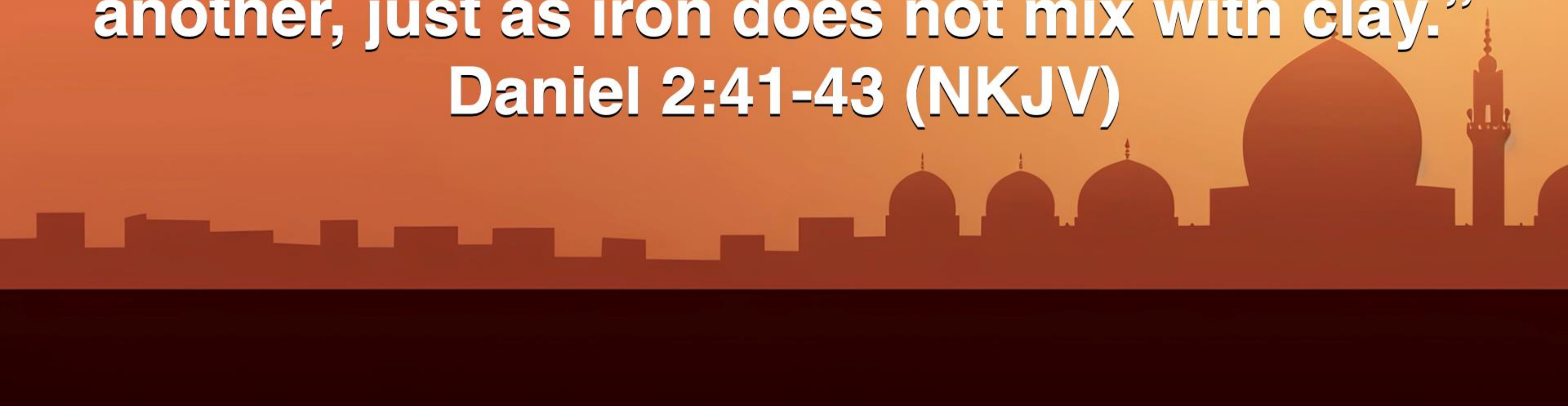




# **F) The Stone that Crushed the Kingdoms:**

## 2. Daniel's 2nd Vision. (Daniel 7)



“In the first year of Belshazzar king of Babylon, Daniel had a dream and visions of his head while on his bed. Then he wrote down the dream, telling the main facts.  
2 Daniel spoke, saying, “I saw in my vision by night, and behold, the four winds of heaven were stirring up the Great Sea. 3 And four great beasts came up from the sea, each different from the other.”

will and became great.” Daniel 8:3,4 (NKJV)

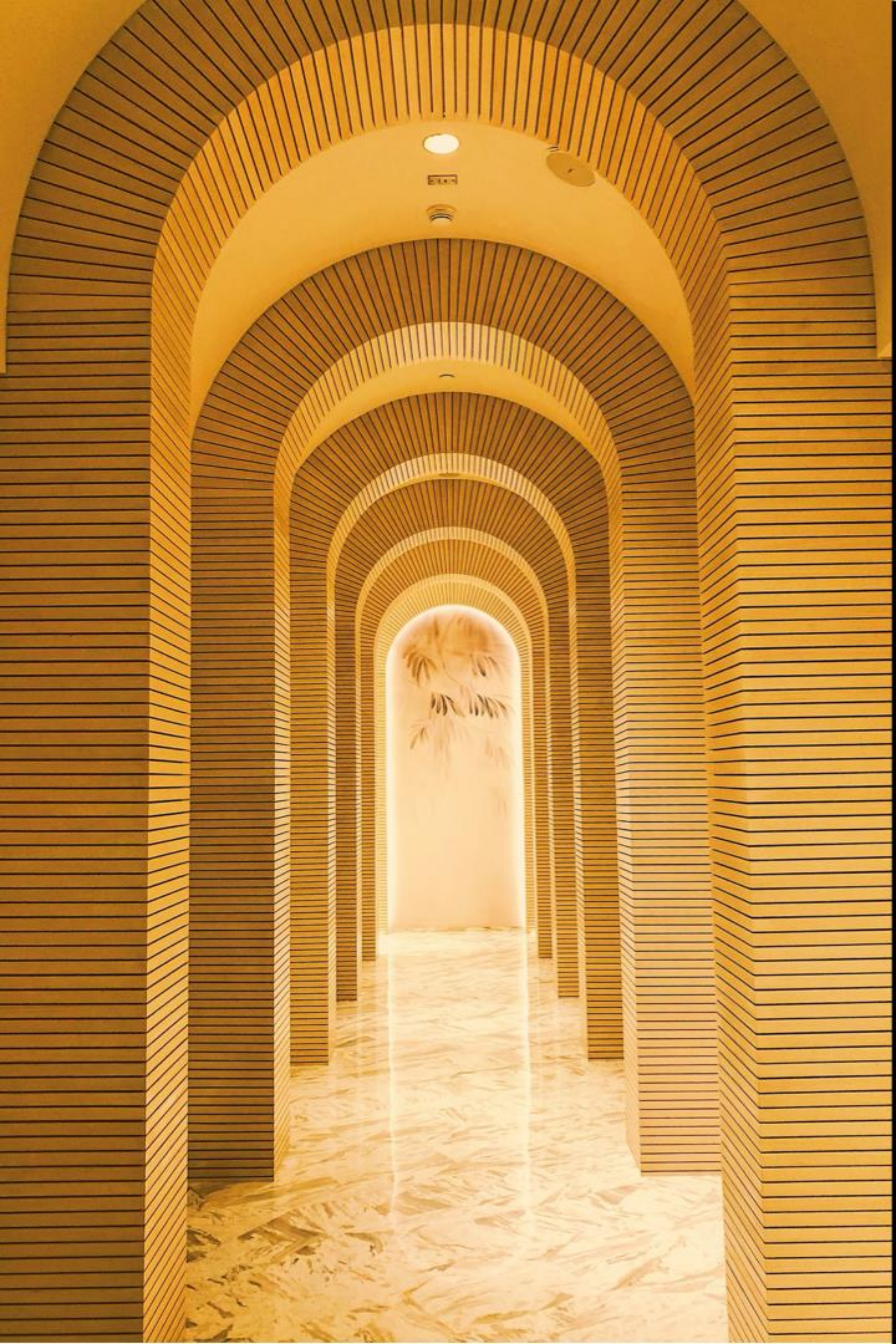


“And as I was considering, suddenly a male goat came from the west, across the surface of the whole earth, without touching the ground; and the goat had a notable horn between his eyes.” ...

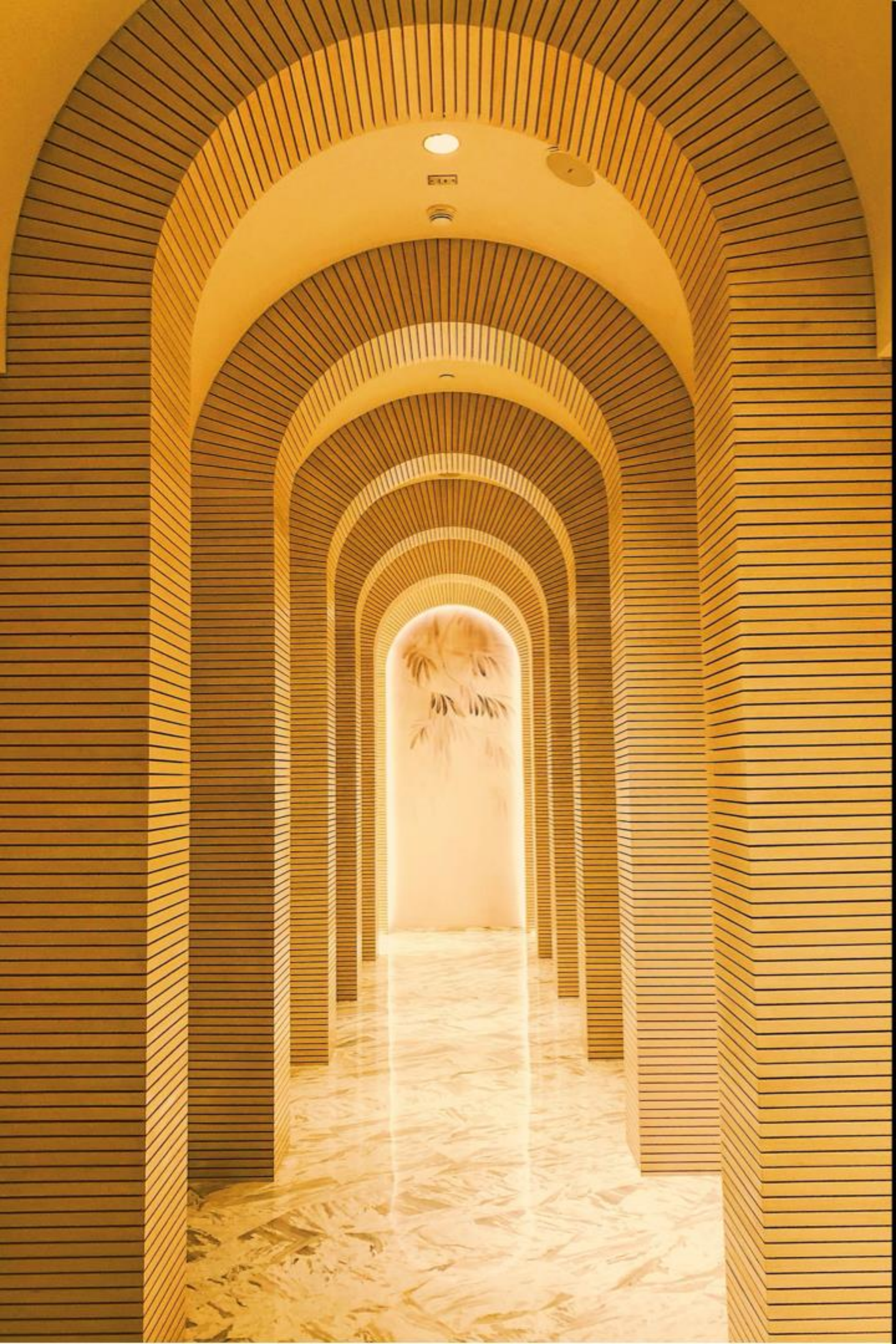

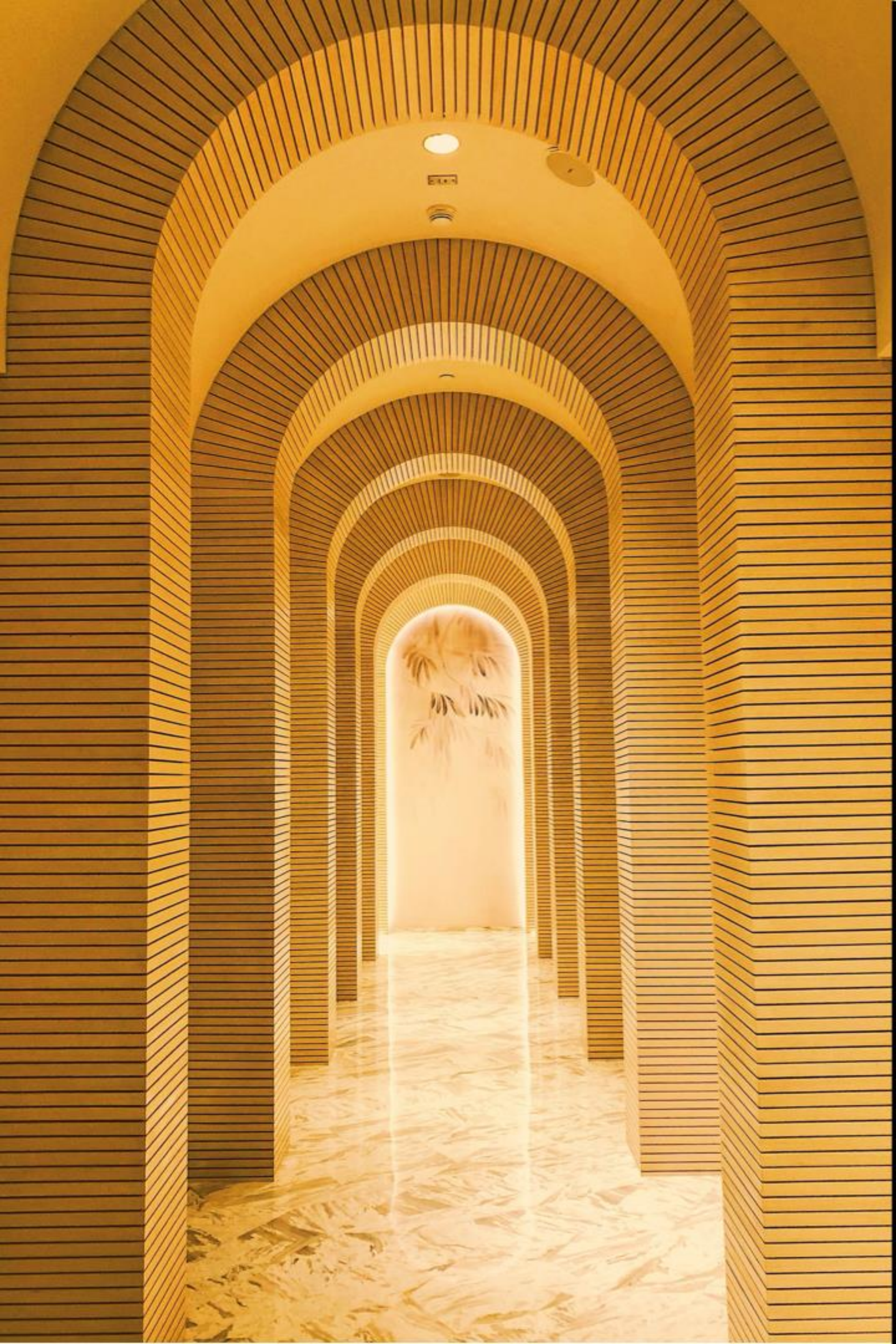

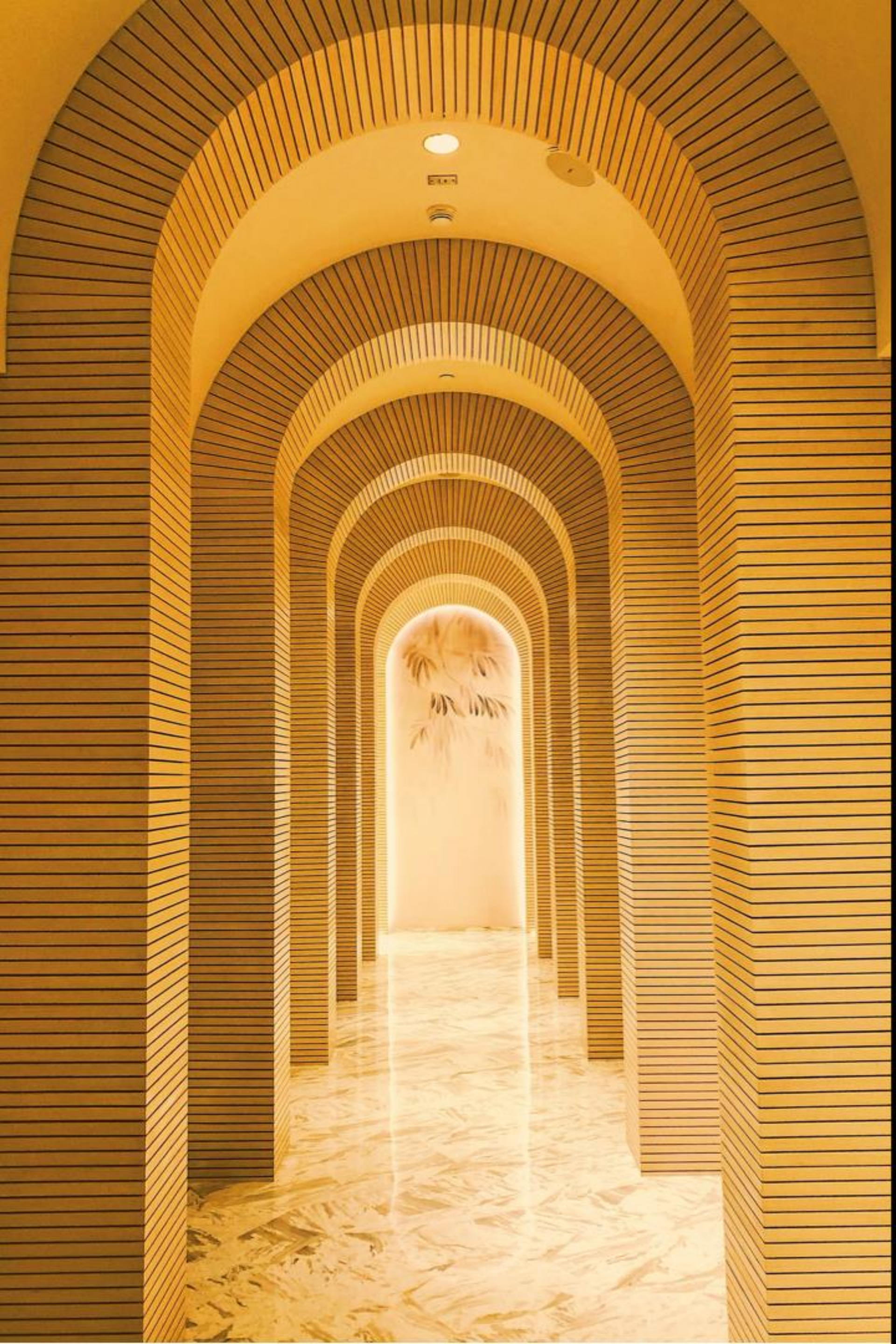
**11 He even exalted himself as high as the Prince of the host; and by him the daily sacrifices were taken away, and the place of His sanctuary was cast down.**

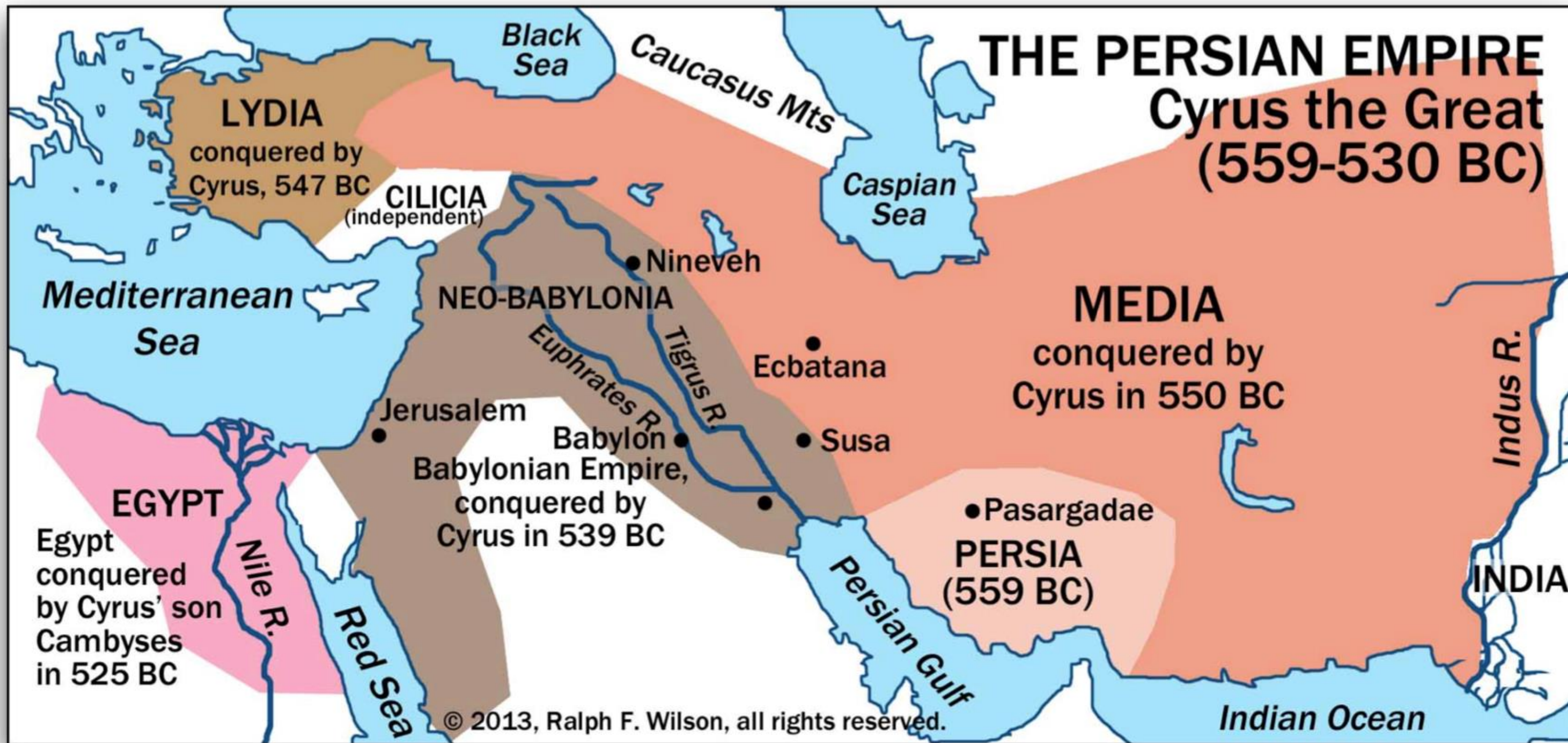


**B) Gabriel Helps Daniel to Understand the Vision:**




