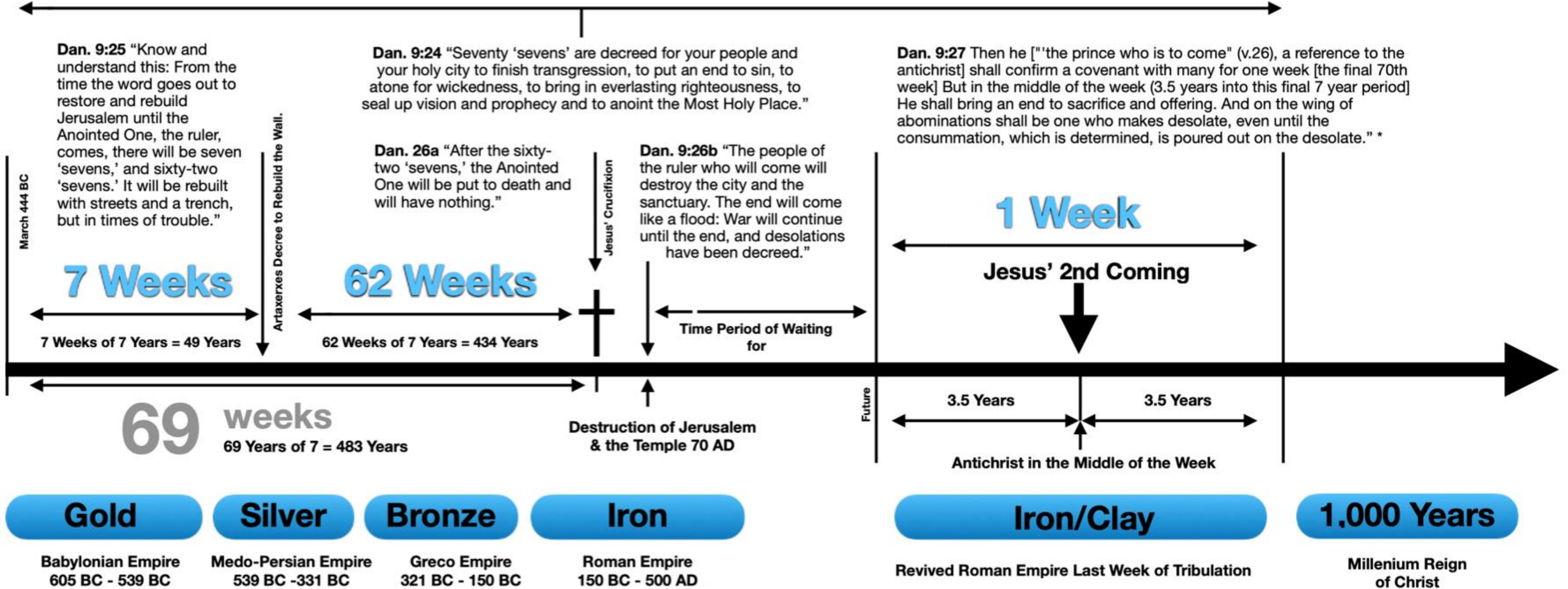

Holloway's illustration is originally Dispensational. This illustration is modified to illustrate a Mid-Tribulation interpretation of eschatology.

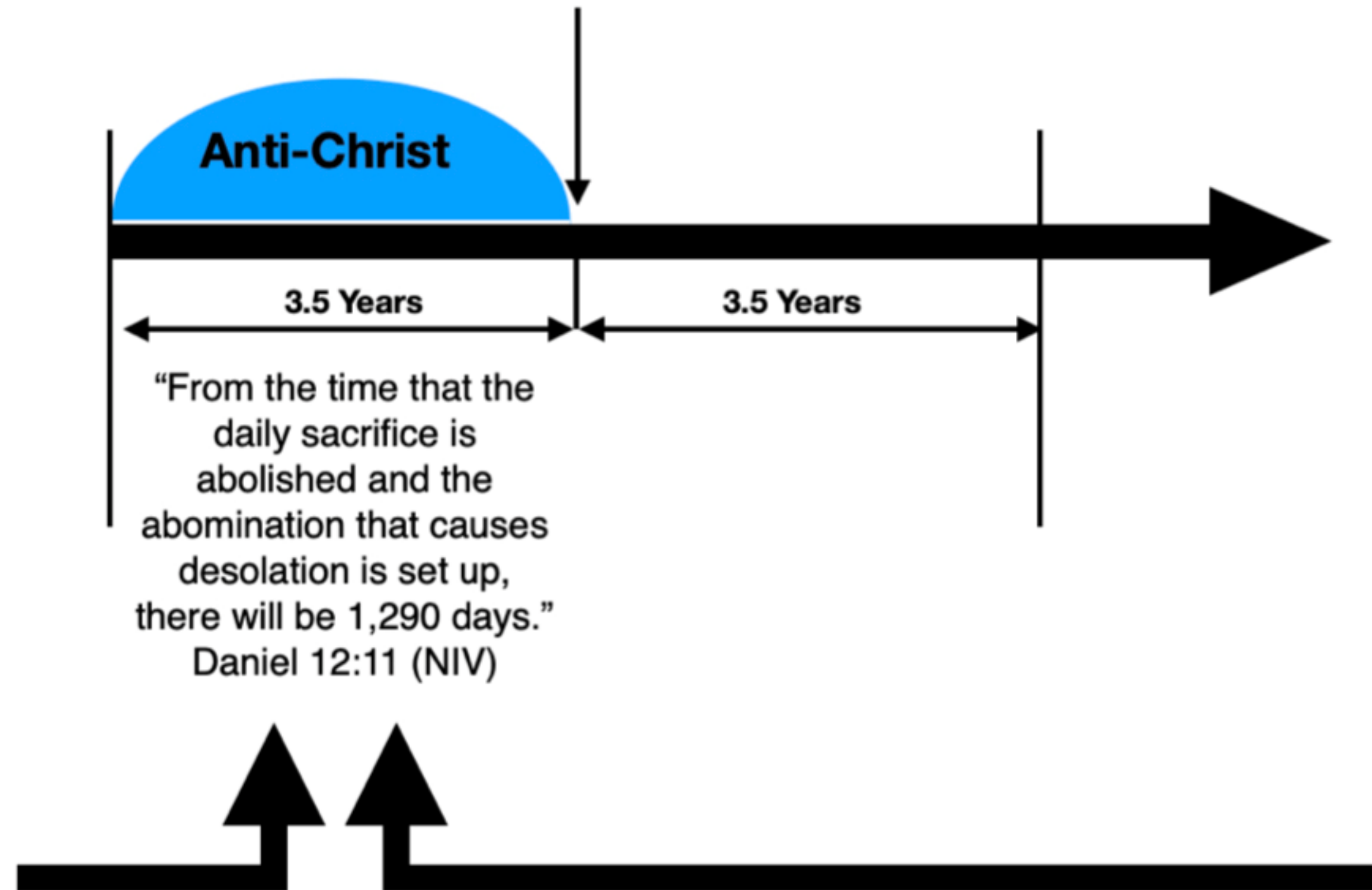
Anti-Christ's Reign Until the Rapture

**Jesus' 2
Coming**

“For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. 17 Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air.” 1 Thessalonians 4:15-17

The Anti-Christ will set himself as god in the Jewish Temple and stop the sacrificial system. He will become the abomination of desolation.

“27 Then he [the anti-Christ] shall confirm a covenant with many for one week; but in the middle of the week, He shall bring an end to sacrifice and offering. And on the wing of abominations shall be one who makes desolate, even until the consummation, which is determined, is poured out on the desolate.”
Daniel 9:27 (NKJV)



The Anti-Christ will make war on mankind and the saints for forty-two months, 3 1/2 years or 1,290 days.

“5 And he was given a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies, and he was given authority to opine for forty-two months. 6 Then he opened his mouth in blasphemy against God, to blaspheme His name, His tabernacle, and those who dwell in heaven. 7 It was granted to him to make war with the saints and to overcome them.”
Revelation 13:5-7 (NKJV)



1. The Beast:



“Then I stood on the sand of the sea.
And I saw a beast rising up out of the
sea, having seven heads and ten
horns, and on his horns ten crowns,
and on his heads a blasphemous
name. 2 Now the beast which I saw
was like a leopard, his feet were
like the feet of a bear, and his mouth
like the mouth of a lion.

The dragon gave him his power, his throne, and great authority. 3 And I saw one of his heads as if it had been mortally wounded, and his deadly wound was healed. And all the world marveled and followed the beast.



4 So they worshiped the dragon
who gave authority to the beast;
and they worshiped the beast,
saying, “Who is like the beast?
Who is able to make war with him?”
Revelation 13:1-4 (NKJV)



“And he was given a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies, and he was given authority to continue for forty-two months. 6 Then he opened his mouth in blasphemy against God, to blaspheme His name, His tabernacle, and those who dwell in heaven.



7 It was granted to him to make war with the saints and to overcome them. And authority was given him over every tribe, tongue, and nation. 8 All who dwell on the earth will worship him, whose names have not been written in the Book of Life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.” Revelation 13:5-8 (NKJV)

“24 The ten horns are ten kings who shall arise from this kingdom. Then the saints shall be given into his hand for a time and times and half a time.” Daniel 7:24,25 (NKJV)

2. The False Prophet (The Anti Holy Spirit)



“Then I saw another beast coming up out of the earth, and he had two horns like a lamb and spoke like a dragon. 12 And he exercises all the authority of the first beast in his presence, and causes the earth and those who dwell in it to worship the first beast, whose deadly wound was healed. 13 He performs great signs, so that he even makes fire come down from heaven on the earth in the sight of men.” Revelation 13:11-13 (NKJV)

The False Prophet	Holy Spirit
The Dragon	God the Father



“He was granted power to give breath to the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak and cause as many as would not worship the image of the beast to be killed. 16 He causes all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and slave,



to receive a mark on their right hand or on their foreheads, 17 and that no one may buy or sell except one who has the mark or the name of the beast, or the number of his name.” Revelation 13:15-17 (NKJV)

B) The Proclamations of Three Angels

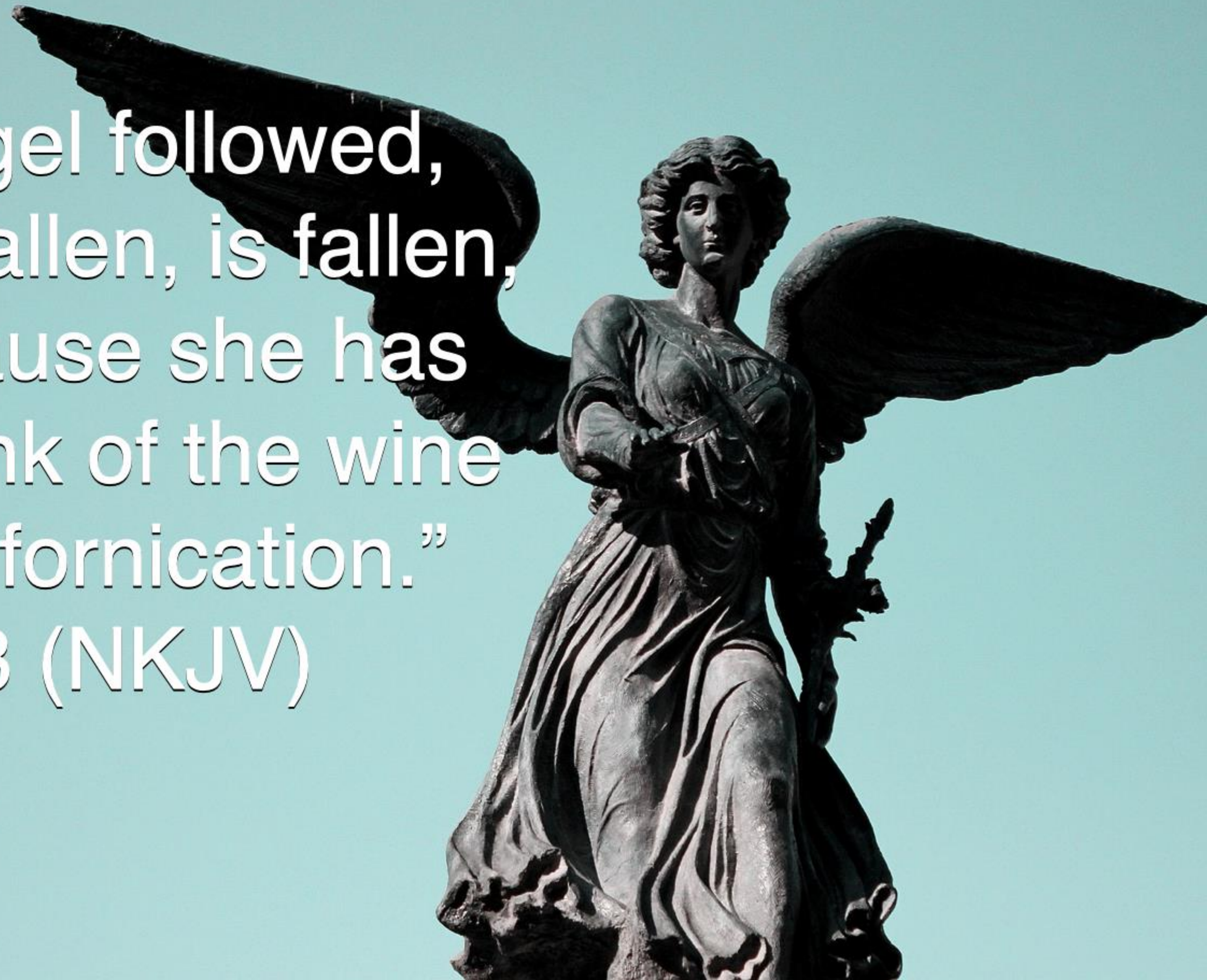




