

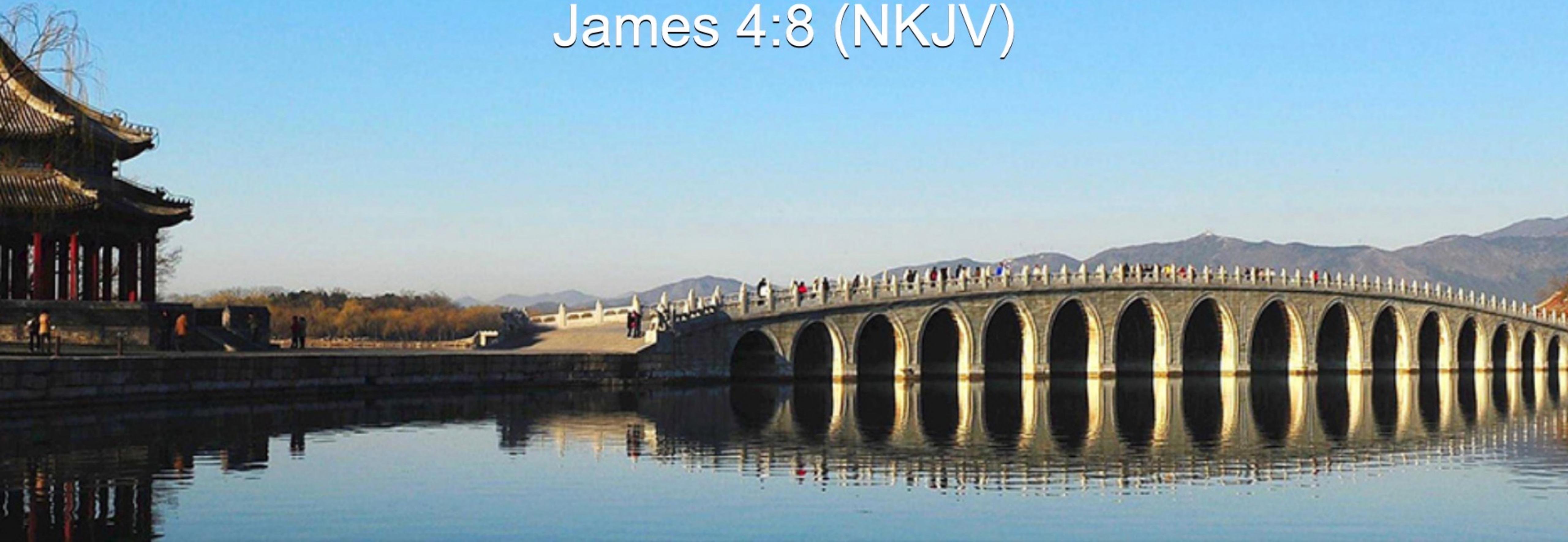



## 2. Be Proud of Your Man:





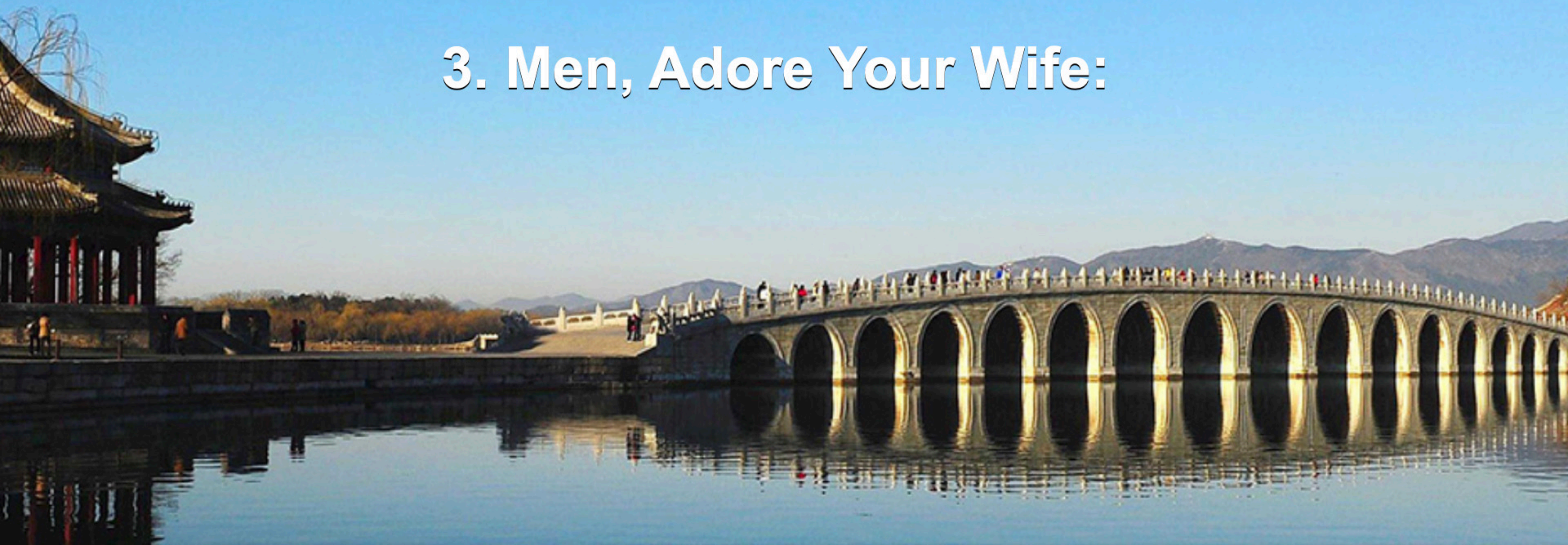

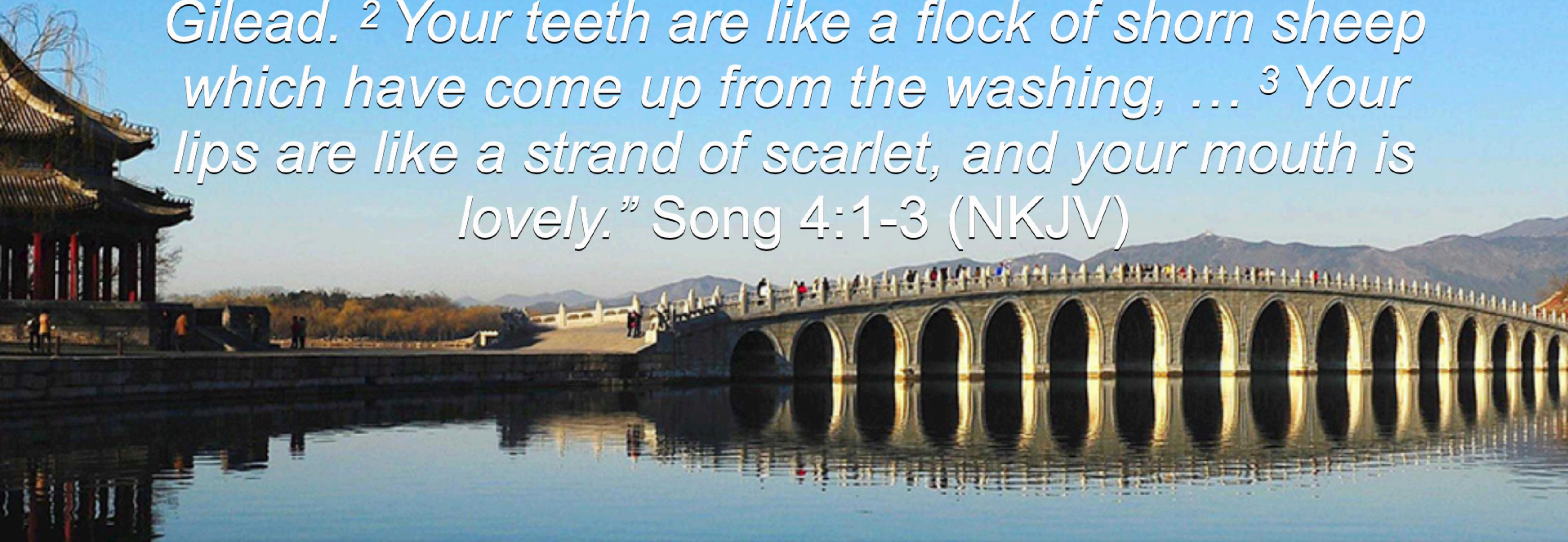
*“By the daughters of Jerusalem. <sup>11</sup> Go forth,

to the hill of frankincense.” Song 4:6 (NKJV)*

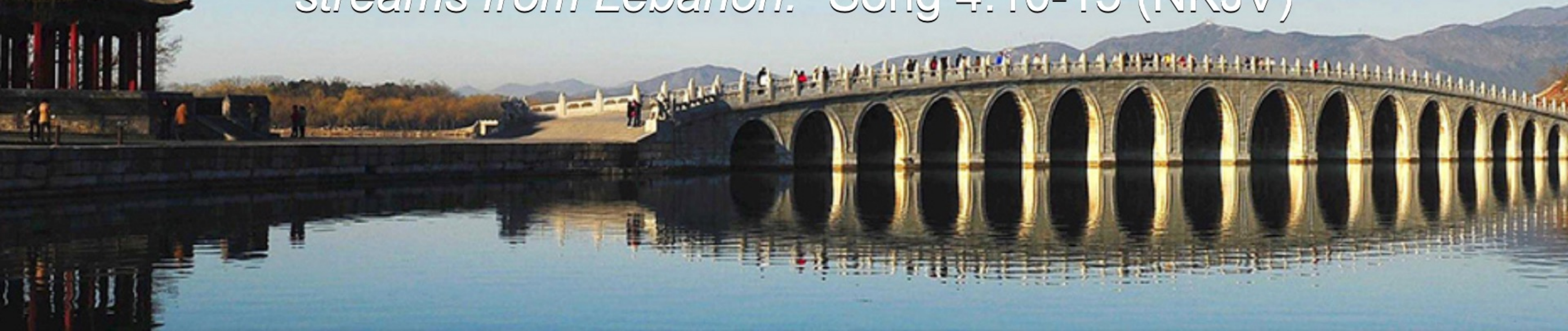
